## 1. INTRODUCTION

Silicon University, Odisha began its journey in 2001 as a degree-level engineering institution under the name Silicon Institute of Technology (SIT). Since its inception, it has been committed to delivering high-quality engineering education while contributing to India's growth in science and technology through rigorous academic programs, promotion of fundamental and applied research, and a strong culture of innovation and entrepreneurship. Over the years, the institution has earned recognition for its dedicated and distinguished faculty, bright and motivated students, and efficient administrative and support staff—factors that enabled its remarkable transformation into a University in record time.

Silicon University, Odisha was formally established in 2024 under the 'Odisha Universities (Amendment) Act, 2020'. Although the University is newly established, it proudly carries forward a rich and accomplished legacy. Its primary focus is to enhance educational and research capabilities and strengthen a value-based academic ecosystem across disciplines. The University is committed to expanding existing departments and introducing new multi-disciplinary and inter-disciplinary programs to meet emerging academic and industry needs.

## 2. PROGRAMS OFFERED

Silicon University, Odisha offers admissions to undergraduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. programs. The seat matrix for all branches of various programs is given as follows:

### 2.1. Undergraduate (Regular) Admissions

Silicon University offers five undergraduate regular programs in engineering whose duration is four years. There is also a provision for admission in the third semester for the lateral entry students whose program duration is three years.

## 2.3. Integrated MCA (iMCA) Admissions

The iMCA program offered by Silicon University features an integrated curriculum in computer applications and information technology. The program aims to prepare software professionals by providing intensive learning opportunities to students after their +2 level. The duration of the program is five years.

The other PG programs offered are MCA (Master in Computer Applications), M.Sc.(Data Science), M.Sc.(VLSI), M.Sc.(Embedded Electronics & IIoT) and M.Sc.(Molecular Medicines). All these postgraduate programs have duration of two years.

## 2.5. Ph.D. Opportunities

Silicon University, with an established research base and extensive infrastructural facilities, offers Ph.D. programs in a wide range of areas in Engineering, Science, Humanities, Social Sciences, and allied interdisciplinary areas. It's dedicated Research Center anchors and supports an expanding research enterprise committed to producing new knowledge, strengthening existing scholarship and discovering solutions with the potential to benefit society. The offered disciplines are Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Electronics & Instrumentation Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Chemistry, Economics, English, Mathematics, Management, Physics and Psychology.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The candidates who seek admission to Silicon University must be a resident / non-resident Indian National or Persons of Indian Origin holders. The candidate should satisfy the following minimum educational qualification if chooses to study in any of the disciplines:

### 3.1. Undergraduate Admissions

(Lateral Entry)</b> (3 years)	Candidates should have passed minimum THREE years / TWO years (Lateral Entry) Diploma examination with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe and Scheduled Caste category) in ANY branch of Engineering and Technology. OR Candidates should have a B.Sc. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging

		to Scheduled Tribe and Scheduled Caste category) and passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics as a subject.
3.	<b>iMCA</b> (5 years)	Students should have passed +2 Examination with Mathematics / Statistics / Information technology / Information science with 50% (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe and Scheduled Caste category) marks in aggregate from any recognized board.

## 4. SELECTION PROCESS

Admission to all programs offered by the University shall be strictly based on merit. The selection of candidates will be carried out through University-level counseling and/or OJEE counseling, as applicable.

Out of the total sanctioned intake for each program, seats will be filled through **Silicon University Counseling (SUC)** and/or **OJEE Counseling (OJEEC)**, in accordance with the distribution specified in the table below.

## 5. SELECTION CRITERIA

Since the number of applicants for various programs offered by the University is significantly higher than the available seats, admissions are strictly merit-based. The merit list is prepared using scores from relevant entrance examinations or the candidate's academic (career) marks, depending on the program applied for. The selection criteria for the different programs are summarized below.

### Important Notes:

- 1) For eligibility, a combined total of at least 135 marks in Mathematics, Physics, and any one Vocational subject in the +2 Science stream is required for B.Tech. admissions.
- 2) To calculate the weighted average of the three components — NTA score, +2 Science marks, and 10<sup>th</sup> marks, use the following formula:

$$\text{Weighted Avg.} = (0.60 * \text{NTA Score}) + (0.30 * +2 \text{ Sc. Marks}) + (0.10 * 10^{\text{th}} \text{ Marks})$$

#### Explanation of the weights:

- **60% of NTA Score:** The NTA score contributes 60% to the final weighted average.
- **30% of +2 Science Marks:** This contributes 30% to the final weighted average.
- **10% of 10th Marks:** This contributes 10% to the final weighted average.

**Example Calculation:** Let's say the following are the scores:

NTA Score = **80**, +2 Science Marks = **75**, 10<sup>th</sup> Marks = **90**

Weighted Average =  $(0.60 \times 80) + (0.30 \times 75) + (0.10 \times 90) = \mathbf{79.5}$

### 5.1. SUAT (Silicon University Admission Test)

For the 2026–27 admission sessions, the University will conduct SUAT exclusively for the M.Tech. and Ph.D. programs. A detailed notification regarding the syllabus, model questions, test dates, and other relevant information will be published on the University website. Candidates interested in appearing for SUAT-2026 may apply online, and all application-related details will be made available on the University website.

Please note that SUAT-2026 will be conducted exclusively in online mode. Candidates may take the test either on the University campus or at designated centers in major cities, depending on their geographical location.

### 6. RESERVATION POLICY

The reservation categories for candidates admitted to various courses through OJEE counselling will remain as per the existing rules of the Government of Odisha and are subject to change as per Government orders. However, for seats filled through University counselling, the reservation categories and their respective percentages are as follows:

a) Scheduled Caste (SC)	–	8%
b) Scheduled Tribe (ST)	–	12%
c) Women Quota (WQ)	–	30% (in each category)
d) Physically Challenged (PC)	–	3%
e) Economically Weaker Section (EWS)	–	10%

**Note:**

- No reservation category for any course under Lateral Entry admission.
- Separate merit lists to be published for each category of reservation.
- Transfer of vacant seats from one reservation category to General category is applicable only when there are vacant seats in that category.
- Reservation for candidates belonging to SC/ST category is by birth and not by marriage or adaptation. Candidates applying for SC/ST reserved category shall furnish SC/ST certificate from the Tahasildar of the place of birth in Odisha at the time of document verification.
- Nativity certificate of Odisha is mandatory for taking admission against any of the reserved category seats along with other relevant certificates (SC/ST/PC).
- To avail reservation under Women Quota (WQ), the nativity certificate is required and is mandatory. Non-submission of nativity certificate automatically cancels the WQ seat.
- EWS will only be applicable to the programs subject to the approval of appropriate authority.
- All Reservations are applicable to natives of Odisha state only.

**7. ADMISSION CALENDER**

Silicon University, Odisha will publish the admission calendar for that academic session before the commencement of the admission process in its official website: **[www.silicon.ac.in](http://www.silicon.ac.in)**

The important dates/schedules mentioned in the calendar will be only applicable for the seats that will be filled through the University counselling. However, for the seats that will be filled through the OJEE counseling, applicants must visit the official website of OJEE for that academic session and follow the instructions provided there.

**8. LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED**

Candidates who have been allotted a seat through OJEE counseling or have qualified through SUAT-2026 for various programs at Silicon University must bring the following documents when reporting to the University on the notified date.

Verification of documents would be done at the time of admission. On failing to establish correctness in any of the documents, the candidates will not be considered for admission.

## 9. CANCELLATION POLICY

The allotted seat is liable to be cancelled under the following circumstances:

- Information produced by applicant is incorrect. In the event of suppression/distortion his/her candidature will be liable to disqualification.
- Applicant has taken admission in any other institute before taking admission in Silicon University, Odisha.
- Applicant has submitted faked/forged documents.
- The applicant has not cleared all subjects at the 10th, 12th, Diploma, or B.Tech. examination levels.
- Applicant has not secured the minimum eligible percentage of marks needed for admission.
- Applicant does not have the required subject(s) for taking admission as per OJEE guidelines.

- g) Applicant has not produced the original relevant documents (mark sheets, CLC/Transfer/Conduct certificate etc.) at the Admission Office of Silicon University, Odisha on or before the date notified for final verification.
- h) Applicant was rejected by the authorities during document verification.
- i) Applicant was not able to produce the required Reservation Certificate issued from the Competent Authority.
- j) Candidate has failed to participate in the Counseling notified to them.
- k) Even after admission, the authority has all the rights to cancel the candidate's admission in case of any discrepancy. The decision shall be final and binding on the candidate. Silicon University, Odisha cannot be held responsible for any loss/damage arising out of such cancellations of admissions.

All disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts only at Bhubaneswar, Odisha.

## **10. WITHDRAW FROM PROGRAM AFTER ENROLLMENT**

- a) A candidate who desired to leave the institution after joining the program needs to submit a "NO-DUES CERTIFICATE" issued by the competent authority. This should be accomplished by the 'Application of Withdrawal' and original admission fee receipt.
- b) Original certificates will be returned to the candidate only if the above condition 9(a) is satisfied.
- c) Refund policy applies as per the latest UGC/AICTE norms.

## **11. REFUND POLICY**

Refund of fees will be applicable as per the updated UGC/AICTE guidelines. Refundable deposits will be returned, after deductions if any, at the time of completion of course or on cancellation of admissions. The refund will be made through account transfer to the account number mentioned in the withdraw request.

The scholarship is applicable for the first semester only. However, eligible students may continue to receive the scholarship in subsequent semesters subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- The student must maintain a CGPA of 8.5 or above, with no backlog papers.
- The student must maintain a minimum attendance of 80% in the preceding semesters.
- The student must have no pending disciplinary cases.
- The scholarship shall not be applicable to students admitted under the Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) category.

### 12.6. Insurance and Student Welfare Fund

- Every admitted student shall be covered under the University’s accidental insurance policy, which provides coverage for the student and one earning parent.
- In the unfortunate event that a student loses his/her only earning parent during the course of study, the University shall reimburse the remaining academic fees for the rest of the program duration, in accordance with the applicable rules and verification process.

### 13. EDUCATION LOAN ASSISTANCE

Silicon University support students to get bank loans to finance their study for their respective programs.

- A one-time, non-refundable Hostel Registration Charge of Rs. 9,000 shall be payable by all categories of students at the time of hostel admission.
- A mess advance of Rs. 22,500 per semester shall be payable by all hostel residents, which will be adjusted towards the mess charges monthly, calculated as per actual.
- A rebate of 5% on the hostel fees shall be granted to candidates who opt to pay the annual fee in full at the commencement of the academic session.

## 15. TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES

Silicon University offers free transportation for all students within the Bhubaneswar city limits. Residential students may use the buses once a week for travel to the city.

## 16. FEE STRUCTURE
