B.Tech. (Batch: 2024-28, 2025-29) 2025-2026 A.Y.**

The subject registration for 1st & 2nd year B.Tech. supplementary examinations will be done by Examination Section through ERP. The students need to register for the 1st & 2nd year theory papers with "U" and "U(EE)" grade to appear for the supplementary examinations. The students with "C" & "D" grade need to register to appear for the improvement examinations.

The students need to register without fail as per the particulars mentioned below:

No complaint / request by email after 22.06.2026 shall be entertained.

Note:

- The students who have been awarded with a "U" or "U(EE)" grade in a course in the End-Term examinations, are allowed to register and appear for the Supplementary Examinations.
- A student can register for a maximum of 06 (six) subjects to appear in the Supplementary Examinations in which the student was awarded "U" or "U(EE)" grade in a previous examinations including the improvement subjects.
- Students who have obtained a "C" or "D" grade in some theory courses of the current year, are permitted to re-appear for maximum 03 (three) courses in the Examinations for improvement of the grades.
- In any case, the total number of subjects registered for clearing the backlogs and/or improvement of grades, shall be limited to 06 (six) subjects only.
- Students awarded with an "X" grade in a course are not permitted to register for the Supplementary Examination for that course.
- Refer clause no.9.6 of examination manual (2024) for details.
- If the number of selected subjects are exceeding the limit stated above then the examination section keep all rights to remove any of the excess subjects from registration process.
